

EYFS, Term 2

Target: to say the numbers from 0 to 10 and back from 10 to 0 in order

By the end of this half term, children should know and be able to recall the following facts instantly:

Key vocabulary:

zero, one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten

Examples:

In order: 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10

And back again: 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, 0

Top Tips

Use practical resources, for example -

- Counting objects around the home. You could use sweets, Lego, fruit, stones, leaves etc
- Looking for numbers up to 10 when you are out and about. Can your child count on or back from that number?
- Singing number songs where the numbers are going backwards, e.g. Ten fat sausages, ten brown owls, ten in the bed etc.
