Target: Know one more and one less than any number to 10

By the end of this half term, children should know and be able to recall the following facts instantly:

Key vocabulary


more than, less than, fewer, one more, one less, add, plus, subtract, take away

Key questions

What is one more than 7?
What is one less than 9?

Examples:

There are nine bees in the beehive. One more flies in. How many bees are there now? What is one more than nine?



Top Tips:

Try to practise these facts practically. e.g. with food or lego bricks or nature when you are out and about. Practise the language of more and less. When we take one away, how many do we have left now? If we add one more, how many do we have now?
