Target: to know multiplication and division facts for the 5 times table.

Key vocabulary multiply, times, division, divide, share, groups of, lots of, and divided by

Example questions
What is 6 multiplied by 5?
What is 5 times 8?
What is 50 divided by 5?

| 1 X 5 = 5 | 5 ÷ 5 = 1 |
|-------------|-------------|
| 2 X 5 = 10 | 10 ÷ 5 = 2 |
| 3 X 5 = 15 | 15 ÷ 5 = 3 |
| 4 X 5 = 20 | 20 ÷ 5 = 4 |
| 5 X 5 = 25 | 25 ÷ 5 = 5 |
| 6 X 5 = 30 | 30 ÷ 5 = 6 |
| 7 X 5 = 35 | 35 ÷ 5 = 7 |
| 8 X 5 = 40 | 40 ÷ 5 = 8 |
| 9 X 5 = 45 | 45 ÷ 5 = 9 |
| 10 X 5 = 50 | 50 ÷ 5 = 10 |
| 11 X 5 = 55 | 55 ÷ 5 = 11 |
| 12 X 5 = 60 | 60 ÷ 5 = 12 |

Helpful Tips

Practise little and often. Learn it as you make your way to school or whilst you're having your tea. Start by learning up to 6×5 and then tackle the rest. Why not practise whilst keeping active? You could throw and catch or kick a ball whilst learning them! You might like to play songs or chants.

If you know know that $5 \times 5 = 25$, can you use this fact to work out 6×5 ? Test your grownups!
