Example questions

What is 6 multiplied by 5?

What is 5 times 8?

What is 50 divided by 5?

1 X 5 = 5	5 ÷ 5 = 1
2 X 5 = 10	10 ÷ 5 = 2
3 X 5 = 15	15 ÷ 5 = 3
4 X 5 = 20	20 ÷ 5 = 4
5 X 5 = 25	25 ÷ 5 = 5
6 X 5 = 30	30 ÷ 5 = 6
7 X 5 = 35	35 ÷ 5 = 7
8 X 5 = 40	40 ÷ 5 = 8
9 X 5 = 45	45 ÷ 5 = 9
10 X 5 = 50	50 ÷ 5 = 10
11 X 5 = 55	55 ÷ 5 = 11
12 X 5 = 60	60 ÷ 5 = 12

Helpful Tips

Practise little and often. Learn it as you make your way to school or whilst you're having your tea. Start by learning up to 6×5 and then tackle the rest. Why not practise whilst keeping active? You could throw and catch or kick a ball whilst learning them! You might like to play songs or chants.

If you know that $5 \times 5 = 25$, can you use this fact to work out 6×5 ? Test your grownups!
